Day 1/2: Depart hometown en route to Mumbai via London, England

Day 3: Mumbai

Arrival at Mumbai International Airport on BA flight in the early hours of 11 October. Meet, greet and transfer to the hotel. Late breakfast. Meet and greet the group and guide prior to a short day of sight seeing in Mumbai, known as the business capital of India. We will be visiting the Dhobi Ghat, Gateway of India, Marine Drive, Hanging Garden, Jain Temple, Mani Bhawan and Prince of Wales Museum. Dinner in the hotel or a popular city restaurant.

Day 4: Mumbai - Udaipur

Morning free or walk to Nariman Point or the Church Gate area, which is the heart of the city overlooking the Arabian

Sea. There is a well-known shopping area with convenience stores for any items you may need for your trip. After lunch we will proceed to the domestic airport to board the flight to Udaipur, arriving at 17:10 hrs. In-flight meal. Upon arrival at Udaipur transfer to the hotel.

Day 5: Udaipur

After breakfast, a full-day city tour of Udaipur, known as 'the City of Lakes'. We will be visiting the massive Maharana City Palace, Jagdish Temple, Garden of Maidens, Bharatiya Lok Kala Kendra. There will be a visit and dinner in the famous Lake Palace.

Day 6: Udaipur - Kumbhalgarh

After breakfast we will proceed to Kumbhalgarh. Afternoon excursion to Kumbhalgarh Fort in the Mewar Region. The impressive Fort has a 36 km wall as its boundary. Dinner and overnight in the hotel.



Day 7: Kumbhalgarh - Mt Abu

After breakfast we drive to Mt. Abu in the Aravalli Mountain range. Arrive in the beautiful hill resort to check-in for one night. Lunch in the hotel and then we drive to Delware and the Jain Temples. After walking around Lake Nakki we will have dinner in the hotel.

Day 8: Mt Abu - Jodhpur

After breakfast, we will travel to Jodhpur - also known as Sun City. On arrival check-in at the hotel. Our lunch will be enroute, a different experience! Rest for a while, then ride to Sardar Samond Market in the Old City by rickshaw or horse cart. The old fashioned market surprises travellers with traditional groceries, textile buyers and sellers in the narrow lanes. Sumptuous dinner in the hotel.

Day 9: Jodhpur

After breakfast we will be ready for a busy sight-seeing tour, including Mehrangarh Fort, Jaswant Thada, Umaid Bhawan Palace and Museum. Lunch in a local restaurant. Dinner in the hotel

Day 10: Jodhpur - Bikaner

After breakfast we check out and take a drive to the great historical city of Rajasthan - Bikaner. The lunch will be enroute and in the afternoon we will arrive at the hotel. Rest for a while before an evening walk. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

Day 11: Bikaner

After breakfast get ready for the full day city sight seeing tour of Bikaner starting with the Junagarh Fort - the palace of erstwhile rulers of Bikaner - Cinetops, and a Camel farm. Dinner at the hotel.

Day 12: Bikaner - Jaipur

Check-out after breakfast, for the panoramic drive to Jaipur - the provincial Capital of Rajasthan, also known as the Pink City. We will be here during the start of the Festival season. Your evening will be free for rest and dinner in the hotel.

Day 13: Jaipur

A full day of sight seeing starts with a morning elephant

ride to Amber Fort, returning to the city for lunch. Then we visit the City Palace, Observatory Palace of the Winds and the Birla Temple and drive past the Albert Hall. Dinner in the hotel with continental, Indian, and Chinese food.

Day 14: Jaipur - Agra

After breakfast we check out and start the drive to Agra. Enroute we will visit Fatehpur Sikri. The abandoned city remains a perfectly preserved Moghul Kingdom. Arrive in Agra and check into the hotel for two nights. Dinner offers a wide variety of food in the hotel. Early to bed in preparation for ...

Day 15: Agra

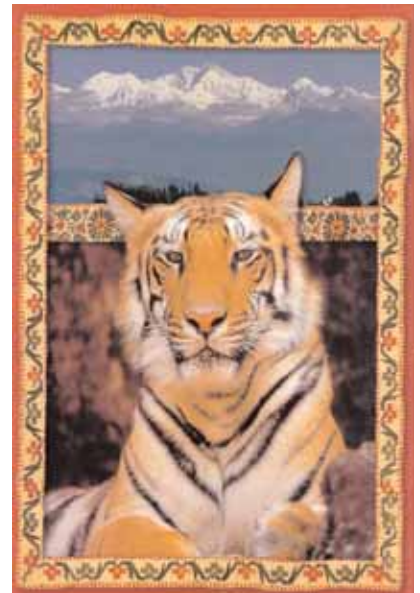
... your wake-up call at 05.00hrs. We meet our guide in the hotel lobby who will take us for a sunrise visit to the beautiful monument of eternal love, The TAJ MAHAL. A single visit to The Taj is never sufficient! Soak in the atmosphere and beauty (and of course take photographs) until it's time to return to the hotel for breakfast and to get ready for another memorable tour: Agra Fort on the banks of the Jamuna River. We will visit a local restaurant for lunch. Rest in the evening or visit the local handicrafts, marble inlay and pottery stores close by.

Day 16: Agra - Gwalior

After an early breakfast we will be on our way to the destination of Gwalior - the princely states of Sciendhias. We transfer to the railway station to board the 2002 Shatabdi Express for Gwalior. It will be a one and half hour train journey. In the afternoon we visit the City Palace and have a tour of Gwalior. There will be an evening Sound and Light show. Dinner and overnight at hotel

Day 17: Gwalior - Khajuraho

After breakfast we transfer to the railway station to board the 2002 Shatabdi Express to Jhansi. Arriving in Jhansi at 10:40hrs Drive to Khajuraho via Orcha. where we will enjoy lunch in the resort. Visit the Museum. Arrive in Khajuraho, check in to the hotel for 2 nights



Day 18: Khajuraho

Full day tour of the Heritage Temples. The eternal images of love. The temples are divided into three geographical groups - Western, including Kendariya Mahadev, Chaunsath

Yogini and others, as well as Eastern and Southern Temples. Dinner in the hotel.

Day 19: Khajuraho - Varanasi

After breakfast you have the morning free until the departure of your flight to Varanasi at 13.30hrs. Lunch in flight. We arrive and transfer to the hotel, en-route visiting Sarnath, the holiest place for Buddhism, where Lord Buddha preached his first sermon to his favourite disciples. Dinner in the hotel.



Day 20: Varanasi - Delhi

Early in the morning we will take a boat ride on the river Ganges, the holiest river in India. We will then visit the narrow lanes of one of the most ancient living cities in the world. We will also visit the Viswanath Temple, Benaras Hindu University and Bharat Mata Temple. In the afternoon we transfer to the airport for our flight to Delhi. On arrival at 17.25 hrs we transfer to our hotel.

Day 21: Delhi

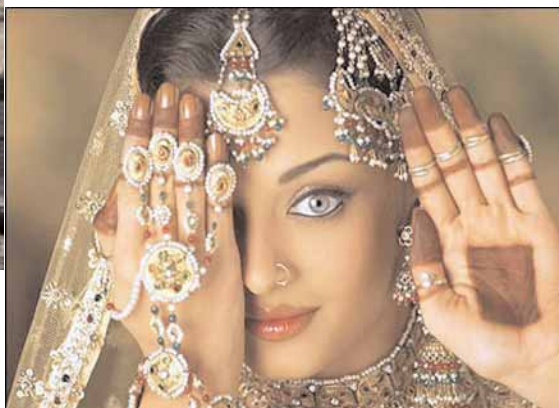
We will have a full day visiting the old and the new Delhi including Rajghat, Red Fort, Chandni Chock, India Gate, President House, Qutab Minar and Lotus Temple. Dinner in the hotel.

Day 22: Delhi

After breakfast your day is free to further explore the city and shop in the varied stores and the Government Emporium. We will then enjoy a farewell dinner at the hotel. There will be a late evening transfer to the International Airport for your flights back home.

YOUR TOUR COST INCLUDES:

- All flights and ground transportation as described in the itinerary.
- Accommodations based on two persons sharing a double room, with private bathroom, at the hotels listed in the itinerary or similar. Single supplement will apply in the case of single occupancy. Sharing can be arranged.
- Transfers between airports and hotels will be provided when travelling with the group. Alternative transfers will be the tour member's responsibility. No refunds will be made for unused services.
- Meals at selected restaurants or hotel dining rooms as specified in the itinerary. Alternative meals, if desired, will be at the member's own expense. There will be no refunds for the forfeited meal.
- Baggage transfers; limited to two pieces of luggage per person. Carry-on luggage and check-in baggage dimensions must conform to the regulations set forth by the airlines used. All excess baggage charges are the sole responsibility of the passenger. Baggage handled at owner's risk.
- Most service charges at hotels and restaurants.

YOUR TOUR COST DOES NOT INCLUDE:

- Medical Insurance out of Province/Country – Do not travel outside your province or Canada without medical insurance.
- Cancellation & Interruption insurance – It is a requirement to have Cancellation & Interruption insurance with ALL The Travel Society tours.

UNUSED AND AMENDED TOUR ARRANGEMENTS:

- Unused accommodation, tour features and services are non-refundable and non-exchangeable for other accommodation, services or features. Should there be reason to change features of the tour; any additional costs will be charged to the tour members.

THE PAYMENT SCHEDULE:

- The non-refundable deposit of C\$500 per person is payable at time of booking.
- Full payment is due 60 days prior to departure, a 'Final Payment Request' will be couriered/express-mailed/e-mailed to you around that time along with any other relevant information.
- All payments made by a credit card (we accept Visa & M/C only) are subject to a nominal convenience charge.

CANCELLATION POLICY:

- All cancellations must be sent to The Travel Society in writing without delay. The following cancellation fees will apply:
 - From reservation up to 60 days prior to departure ~ cancellation fee: the full deposit
 - 59 to 31 days prior to departure ~ cancellation fee: 60% of the tour price
 - 30 days or less prior to departure ~ cancellation fee: 100% of the tour price
- Important: With ALL reservations made with The Travel Society Cancellation & Interruption Insurance is required.

LATE HANDLING FEE:

- Bookings made within 30 days of departure may be subject to a late handling fee of \$50 per person.

OTHER TERMS:
