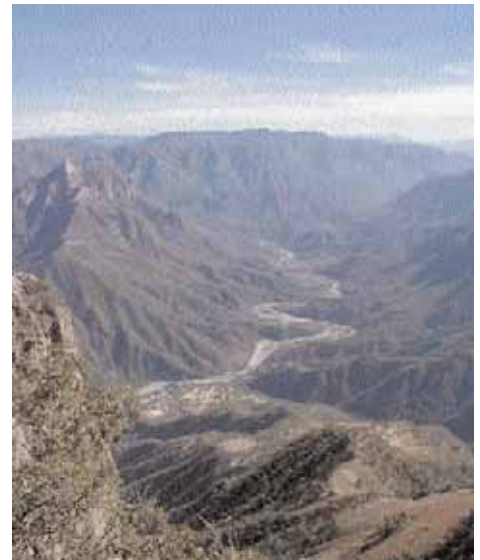

Day 1: Canada - Mexico City

Arrive Mexico City and transfer to the Hotel Imperial (or similar) in the famous Zona Rose. The Hotel Imperial Reforma is a 4-star classic hotel in the French style that dates from 1904. It combines the elegance of its 19th century design with 21st century amenities and is perfectly located in the Pink Zone. Balance of the day at leisure to relax or explore Mexico City. (B)

Day 2: Mexico City

After breakfast in the hotel, depart for a day tour of the city, including the art-laden National Palace, the magnificent Cathedral and the Plaza of Three Cultures, Then it's on to the delightful and prosperous residential areas of St.

Angel and Coyoacan where it's hard to believe you're in Mexico City. Choose your own delightful patio or restaurant for lunch here, before returning to central Mexico City and your hotel. (B)

Day 3 - Sightseeing from Mexico City

After breakfast at the hotel, depart on a full day tour to the outskirts of Mexico City. Visit the Shrine of the Virgin of Guadalupe - Mexico's most revered site - and then travel on to the mysterious pre-Aztec ruins of Teotihuacan. Marvel at the vast vistas, and the gigantic pyramids of the Sun and the Moon and ponder the eternal question: "What happened here?" over lunch under the trees in one of the site's nearby restaurants. (B L)

Day 4 - Mexico City

After breakfast we're off on a tour of a most unusual place - the floating gardens of Xochimilco where you'll enjoy a tranquil boat ride through the canals and a delightful lunch. This area is so unique it has been named as a UNESCO Cultural Heritage Site. We'll then return to the centre of town for a visit to the world-renowned Museum of Anthropology with time for a pleasant walk in adjoining Chapultepec Park. (B L)

Day 5 - Los Mochis

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for the flight to Los Mochis. Upon arrival, transfer to the Posada del Hidalgo Hotel in nearby El Fuerte. Balance of the day free to explore El Fuerte. If time permits you may decide to take a cruise on the Rio Fuerte where you will enjoy watching the wildlife, including many bird species. (B)

Day 6 - Cerocahui

After breakfast, transfer to the train station for the departure of the 'Chepe' train which takes passengers up into the Sierra Madre Mountains, passing through 86 tunnels and crossing 37 bridges. This is one of the most spectacular train rides in the world. Transfer to Hotel Mision in Cerocahui. Today will include a 3-hour tour to Gallego's Overlook on the rim of the Urique Canyon. (B L D)

Day 7 - Posada Barrancas

Breakfast at the hotel, then board the train for Posada Barrancas, close to the town of Devisadero, and the famous Mirador Hotel, overlooking the Copper Canyon. Explore the Canyon on a 2-hour excursion, which will include spectacular canyon views. You will have time to visit the unique caves of the Tarahumara Indians here. (B L D)

Day 8 - Chihuahua City

Breakfast at El Mirador, then board the train for Chihuahua City. Dinner will be enjoyed on board before evening arrival in Chihuahua. Transfer to the Palacio del Sol Hotel. (B D)

Day 9 - Chihuahua City

Breakfast at the hotel, then depart for a morning sight-seeing tour of the Chihuahua, one of the most important and historic cities in Northern Mexico. **Your tour will visit several interesting sites including the home of Pancho Villa before you are transferred to the airport for your flights home.** If your route takes you back through Mexico City, now that you are familiar with this wonderful place you may decide to stay on for a few extra days. There's still so much to see and you can return to the Hotel Imperial or choose to stay at the famous Majestic Hotel in the heart of the exciting historic district. (B)

YOUR TOUR COST INCLUDES:

- All flights and ground transportation as described in the itinerary.
- Accommodations based on two persons sharing a double room, with private bathroom, at the hotels listed in the itinerary or similar. Single supplement will apply in the case of single occupancy. Sharing can be arranged.
- Transfers between airports and hotels will be provided when travelling with the group. Alternative transfers will be the tour member's responsibility. No refunds will be made for unused services.
- Meals at selected restaurants or hotel dining rooms as specified in the itinerary. Alternative meals, if desired, will be at the member's own expense. There will be no refunds for the forfeited meal.
- Baggage transfers; limited to two pieces of luggage per person. Carry-on luggage and check-in baggage dimensions must conform to the regulations set forth by the airlines used. All excess baggage charges are the sole responsibility of the passenger. Baggage handled at owner's risk.

UNUSED AND AMENDED TOUR ARRANGEMENTS:

- Unused accommodation, tour features and services are non-refundable and non-exchangeable for other accommodation, services or features. Should there be reason to change features of the tour, any additional costs will be charged to the tour members.

THE PAYMENT SCHEDULE:

- The non-refundable deposit of C\$500 per person is payable at the time of booking.
- Full payment is due 70 days prior to departure, an Invoice/Final Payment Request will be couriered/express-mailed/e-mailed to you Prior to that time, along with any other relevant information.
- All payments made by a credit card are subject to a convenience charge based on a percentage current at the time of payment.

CANCELLATION POLICY:

- All cancellations must be sent to The Travel Society in writing without delay. The following cancellation fees will apply:
 - From reservation up to 60 days prior to departure ~ cancellation fee: the full deposit
 - 59 to 31 days prior to departure ~ cancellation fee: 60% of the tour price
 - 30 days or less prior to departure ~ cancellation fee: 100% of the tour price

LATE HANDLING FEE:

- Bookings made within 30 days of departure may be subject to a late handling fee of \$50 per person.
